#### **JULY 1: NONPROFIT FINANCIAL BASICS**

Developing a financially healthy Nonprofit is key to creating sustainability. This webinar provides information on basic financial requirements that impact Nonprofit operation. Participants will learn the stages of Nonprofit Growth & Development, board fiduciary duties, and Nonprofit budgeting concepts.

#### **JULY 8: NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION FORMATION**

Learn the "how to" of Nonprofit start-up in North Carolina. This webinar focuses on the 3-step Nonprofit formation process at the state, local, and federal levels. Participants will learn the critical role the Board of Directors plays in providing administrative and financial management of the Nonprofit.

#### **JULY 15: NONPROFIT BUSINESS PLANNING**

Nonprofit business planning creates a detailed map that helps the organization meet its mission. This webinar provides basic information on how to develop a Nonprofit business plan. Participants will learn how business planning relates to Nonprofit operations and the basic elements of a Nonprofit business plan.

#### JULY 22: USING TECHNOLOGY TO IMPROVE NONPROFIT IMPACT

Technology is a critical part of Nonprofit operations. This webinar demonstrates how Nonprofits can effectively utilize web and email communications, online fundraising tools, and social media.
